Recreational Services DED Dodgeball Rules

- Teams will be made up of as many players as the captain wishes with the maximum of six (6) and minimum of two
 (2) playing at a time on a side; additional players will be available as substitutes.
- 2. The playing field will be the volleyball court divided into two (2) equal sections by the half-court line.
- 3. The balls to be used are during the tournament are volleyballs.
- 4. Each match will consist of best 4 out of 7 games.
- 5. The game is won once all players from a team have been eliminated.
- 6. Each game will have an 5 minute time limit with the team having the most players remaining declared the winner.
 - a. If there is a tie, sudden death rules will go into effect.
 - b. Sudden Death: First team to have a player eliminated is the loser. (4v4)
- 7. A player is eliminated when:
 - a. Hit with a LIVE thrown ball below the shoulders.
 - i. All head shots will not count; neither the thrower nor player hit is eliminated.
 - b. Catching a LIVE ball thrown by your opponent before it touches the ground.
 - i. If a ball is caught, the team that has caught the ball brings one player back onto the court.
 - c. Exiting Playing Surface Illegally
 - i. Any player who exits the side boundary for any reason is eliminated.
 - ii. Any player who exits the back boundary avoiding a ball is eliminated.
 - d. A ball used as a blocker is dropped upon contact from a thrown ball.
- 8. **Live Ball Definition:** A ball that has been thrown and has not touched anything, including the floor/ground, another ball, another player, official or other item outside of the playing field (wall, ceiling, etc)
 - a. If a player deflects the ball off of themselves, they are out
- 9. A player may only be hit when they are on the playing court; when they are retrieving balls they are not able to be eliminated.
- 10. In order to retrieve balls, players must exit and enter through the back end line.
- 11. Opening Rush
 - a. Each team will have three balls to begin play
- 12. Each team will be allowed one 30-second timeout per match.
 - a. During the timeout, teams may substitute 1 player.
 - b. This player must be the next person in line to re-enter the game
- 13. A team may not possess all 6 balls for more than 5 seconds at a time.
 - a. If this occurs, a dead ball is declared and balls are divided 3 and 3 among the teams.
- 14. Sportsmanship Ratings will be determined by officials after matches are complete.
 - a. If a team is given a "C" sportsmanship rating, disqualification from the tournament is possible.
