#### Budget review - Dan

- Key part of the budget is to make sure all student leaders know what is going on.
- Instead of allocating each student group a certain amount of funds everyone starts out at \$150.
- Implemented the service opportunity fund. Once student groups have exceeded their 10 hours of community service they will be reimbursed \$8 per hour per person for service work. We did this to ensure student groups who want to be successful can be.
- In the past we did budget hearings and a lot of times student groups would have a lot of money sitting in their accounts if their leadership was not as strong as the year before.
- Can earn max of \$1500 with the SOF. We still have the LDF (leadership development fund students who go off campus to gain skills and bring them back to campus) and CDF (community development fund special events, speaker, putting on event for Augie students)
- \$1500 in Senate and Executive accounts. CDF and LDF have \$4500 each, and the SOF has \$25,000.
- Won't have ASA allocation until after 10<sup>th</sup> day of classes.

## Bike Share Program - Elliot

- Augie Green had a bike share program but it has dwindled.
- Noticed high demand for bikes for transportation. Looking at ways we can bring bikes to Augustana.
- One option is a full service plan, but it costs \$15,000 annually for 12 bikes. Another option is to buy a system from a company, but you have to operate it yourself and that is \$1000 per bike. The bike, is heavy duty so you don't have to maintain it and a lock box, rack, and u-lock are included. The do it yourself program is ideal in a more robust manner that has longevity.
- Do you as a senate have any interest in going after this?
- Looking if we can upgrade bike racks around campus.
- Two Wheeler Dealer is willing to give us good prices on bikes that have internal gearing and are comfortable and efficient.
- *Joel H* What happens to bikes that are left behind by students each year?
- *Elliot* They sell those bikes to people who need alternative modes of transportation and the bike club has taken this as a service project. We could also sell these to students and have them sell them back at the end of the year for half price.
- Also thinking of ways to better register bikes.
- Kat Is this something ABC would do?
- *Elliot* It would be good if it came out as Augustana's bike program. Another way would be for ASA to contract the bike club and operate it.
